Anja will also present a comparative study of historical and contemporary photographers and filmmakers, from documentary to conceptual.

Anja Hitzenberger is a photographer and filmmaker whose work focuses on the body in relationship to architecture and space. Her work has been exhibited in both group and one-person shows in New York and throughout Europe, and published internationally in magazines, books and newspapers. Her short film, "Barcelona in 48 Hours," which is made almost entirely out of black and white photographs, has been screened across 20 festivals over the world. She has received numerous grants, commissions and residencies for her photography and video projects. The architecture and colors of cities around the world inspire her work, and she enjoys collaborating with people she meets on her many travels.
