This full day workshop will focus on photographing subjects inside using one light source to create various effects. By controlling the direction of the light and the use of accessories such as umbrellas, light modifiers, grids and more, this will give you creative options beyond the capability of your on-camera strobe. After demonstrations and discussions the group will break up into 4 groups to practice light setups. We will pull Polaroids to immediately see the results. Additionally light meters will be demonstrated and everyone will have full understanding of their use by the end of the day.

Understanding how to use a single light source will give everyone the flexibility to travel lightly, work without an assistant and achieve a creative, professional end result.

>Andrew French, a working photographer for 21 years and on the faculty of  
>ICP for 6 years, will be teaching this workshop. Andy moved to New York  
>City from Rockford, IL, in 1981 with a duffle bag, a banjo, and a camera  
>bag. From 1981 to 1990 he worked as an assistant to over 70 photographers,  
>including Annie Leibovitz, Mary Ellen Mark and Ruth Orkin. He currently  
>photographs for magazines and commercial clients, including Food and Wine,  
>Gourmet, Esquire, Mens Health, Fast Company and Money.

The workshop will be held in Splashlight Studios, which affords us one of the most professional studio space and lighting equipment in NYC- a location that would cost thousands of dollars for a regular shoot.
